### **Background**

Tanzania Youth Vision Association [TYVA] is a youth-led, non-partisan, non-profit, and non-governmental and membership based organization founded in 29th July 2000 and registered with a registration number (00NGO/R2/000425) to work as Non Governmental Organization focusing on youth awareness raising and empowerment.

TYVA was established by active, visionary and passionate young Tanzanian who realized and defined their role to address the question of poor youth involvement and participation in political and social economic development issues from grassroots to national level.

Since its inception in 2000, the main objective of the association has been to bring together the youth in Tanzania with a view of realizing and mobilizing their talents and potentials in the spirit of promoting peace, democracy, socio-economic development and protection of the environment.

TYVA is currently in partnership with Hivos East Africa implementing open contracting project which aims to develop a guideline for the 30% of procurement opportunities reserved for youth in Tanzania as envisioned in the Public Procurement law.

### **About the consultancy**

The purpose of this consultancy is to provide guideline for consultancy to review the Tanzania Public procurement act and develop guidelines for the implementation of the 30% reservation for youth Participation in public contracting.

Having observed the importance of participation of this group in public procurement, the Public Procurement Act of 2011 as amended in 2016 has introduced preference that covers the special groups. Pursuant to the

requirements of Section 64 (2) (c) of Public Procurement Act (PPA) Cap 410 (as amended in 2016) and Regulation 30% of Public Procurement Regulations (PPR) of 2013 (as amended in 2016), all Procuring Entities (PEs) shall set aside thirty (30) percent of their annual procurement volume for this group. However, implementation of the section is still insignificant, with low awareness among special groups and government agencies and still there are no guidelines for implementation of the ACT.

### **Responsibilities**

- Meet with management or appropriate staff to understand their requirements
- Conduct situational analysis to identify and understand issues in public procurement in Tanzania.
- Provide advice or suggestions for improvement according to objectives
- Produce guideline for the development on 30% youth reservation in public procurement act and how to engage youth.
- Provide a detailed activity report .
